If this permit is granted, I/we agree to the following conditions:

1. That traffic will be maintained in accordance with Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
2. That disturbance to road surface and shoulders will be kept at a minimum and that trenches will be backfilled with gravel and tamped, so that settlement of the material will be kept to a minimum.
3. That the road surface at the trench will be replaced with the material of the type that was removed and that the new surface will conform with the grade of the undisturbed surface.
4. That all excess material must be removed and disposed of at a proper location.
5. Any areas disturbed on the right-of-way may require grading, seeding, mulching, ditch restoration and any other means necessary to prevent erosion as directed by the Perry County Engineer.
6. That all lines will be buried 36 inches below the bottom of ditch. If no ditch, then 48 inches below the pavement. All lines will be installed around culverts and bridges.
7. Following approval, 48 hours advance notice must be given to the County Engineer before work begins.
8. The County Engineer reserves the right to order the removal, reconstruction, relocation, or repair of any work performed under a permit in the event of future work or for the benefit of the traveling public. The County Engineer further reserves the right to correct or remove work, structures, materials, etc. not in compliance with the requirements of this permit. The cost of the aforementioned work shall be reimbursed to the County by the permit holder.
9. The County Engineer, or his designated representative, may revoke or annul any permit at any time for nonperformance or noncompliance of the conditions set forth by this permit.
10. That I/we assume the responsibility for and will save the County harmless from any and all claims for personal injuries and property damages, and shall defend any action that might be brought due to this work.
11. That responsibility under this permit will remain in force until a release has been granted by the Perry County Engineer.
12. That the owner of any permanent structure (e.g.-utility pole, pedestal, pull box, guy anchor, hydrant, valve box, utility markers, etc...) being placed in the County Road right-of-way, shall maintain vegetation to a maximum height of six (6") inches around said structure, a minimum distance of five (5') feet in any direction from the structure, at all times by all legal means necessary and agreed upon by the County Engineer.
